We welcome project proposals that are concerned with education and/or research themes within the broad umbrella of public relations - from theoretical to practical proposals, from fundamental to applied research, and from 'generic' to 'specialised' areas of public relations. Projects should be proposed by Euprera member/s who is/are then completely responsible for the particular project. The Euprera member who leads the project is called the 'Project Energiser' and reports to the board on the progress of the project as deemed necessary.

If you have an idea for a particular project and would like to 'recruit' other like-minded Euprera members to join you then we can help assist you in this process and connect you with others that have interests and expertise in the area of your proposed project (if your project requires others to participate). We can also help you to identify partners in other EU countries which is helpful if you are interested in putting together a research bid for funding from the EU funding or from national research councils.
